



Terms for participating on guided trips with Kajakk Nord

Participation takes place at your own risk. Kajakk Nord assumes no responsibility for the financial consequences of possible mishaps / injuries that may occur during the events. Exceptions may be liability due to gross negligence by the tour guide, as described by Norwegian law. A condition for participation is that the participants have signed travel / accident insurance.

The guided tours are open to anyone who satisfies the requirements imposed on the participants physical and mental ability to complete the trip.

The participant is obliged to read the program thoroughly and assess whether he / she is physically and mentally able to complete the trip. If a participant is uncertain about own health condition, he/ she is obliged to consult a doctor before beginning the guided tour.

Participants must bring with them the equipment mentioned in the description of the guided tour. Participants are required to follow the instructions of tour guides. If a participant turns out to be physically or mentally unable to complete the trip, is insufficiently dressed or lacking necessary equipment, he / she may be refused to participate or excluded from the rest of the trip. Participants who may have acute health problems (eg. seizures or the like) must be prepared for the trip (for example by bringing medicines and usage instructions). The tour leader must be notified in advance about health issues relevant to the guided tour.

Cancellation

If canceled more than 60 days before departure, a full refund will be given. If canceled between 59 and 30 days before the start of the program, 50 percent will be refunded. If canceled less than 30 days before the start of the program, no refund will be given.
